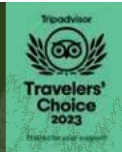

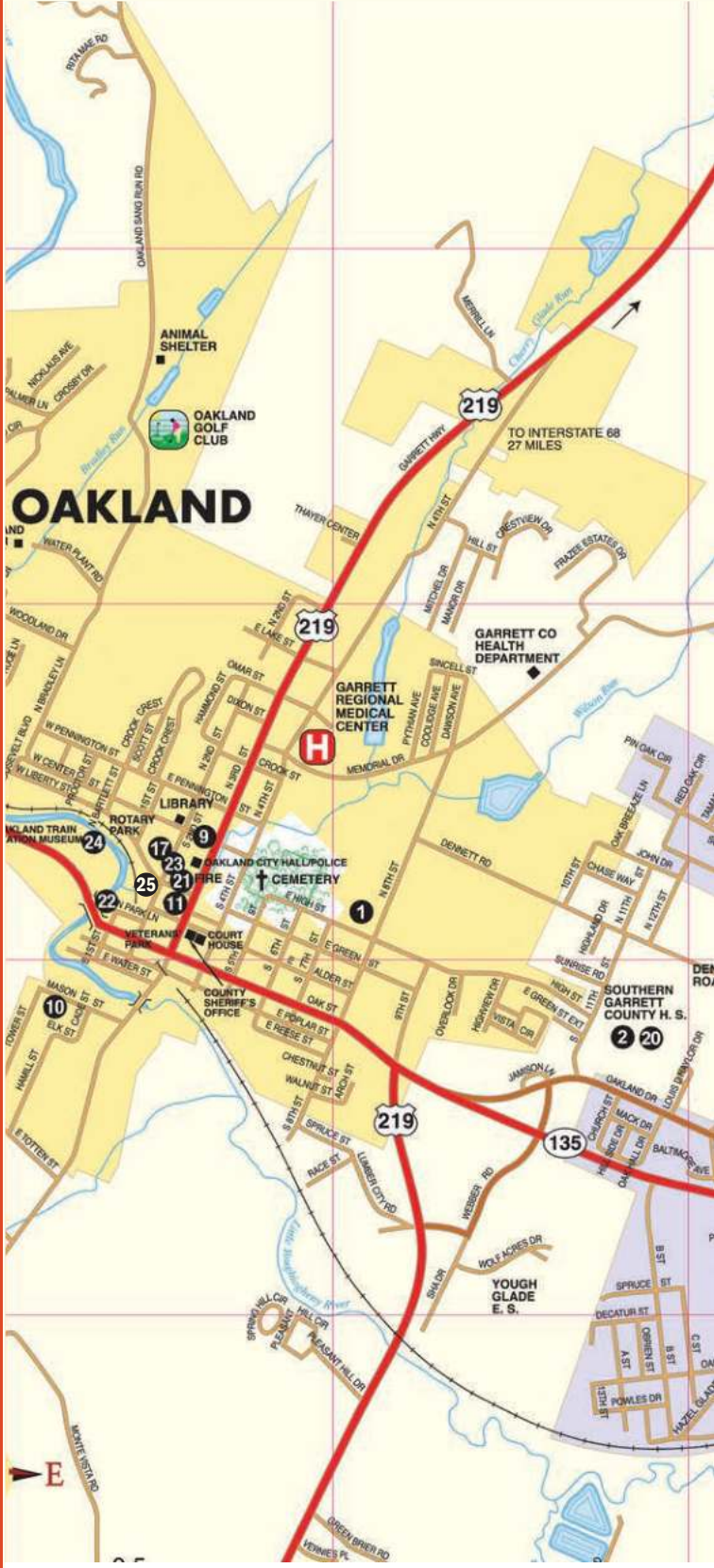

## ROAD CLOSINGS

Garrett Highway/Third Street/Rt 219 will be completely closed to traffic from North 4th Street to Oak Street at 9:30 a.m. Second Street from Omar Street to Alder Street will also be closed to all vehicles at 9:30 a.m. Traffic traveling north and south through Oakland will be directed to detour via Fourth Street until approximately 30 minutes after the parade ends. Center Street will remain open until 12:45 p.m. and will be closed until approximately 30 minutes after the parade ends. Oak Street will remain open for east/west travel.

Memorial Drive also will be closed to through traffic between Fourth and Eighth Street. No one will be able to turn onto Fourth Street from Memorial Drive. Barricades and police officers will prevent access onto Memorial Drive from Fourth to Eighth streets. Emergency vehicles should use Kings Run or Eighth Street to Memorial Drive for hospital access.

Additionally, The Garrett Transit service will provide a shuttle service circulating between Downtown Oakland and out of town parking. The designated route provides parking at Walmart with drop off near Walgreens and an additional location south of Oakland (determined at a later date) with drop off near the town parking lot. Buses will operate on a loop starting at 9:30 a.m. For more information about the shuttle service please call Garrett Transit Services at 301.334.9431.

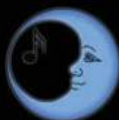

Our two Fall Foliage tours provide you with a guided tour where you will travel along some of our most stunning routes and have the opportunity to stop by some fabulous historic sites. ### Fall Foliage Heritage Driving Tour – Southern Garrett County

This self-guided driving tour will highlight the splendor of Garrett County's Fall Foliage in the Southern end of the county. The ever-popular Swallow Falls State Park is on this trip. We strongly encourage a stop here and take a hike, a picture or just sneak down to the overlook, where you can see the falls from a bird's eye view. Swing by the Rock Maze trail on your way through Garrett State Forest or the Cranesville Subarctic Swamp. The Cranesville Swamp is a boreal peat bog relic left behind from the Pleistocene Epoch. The swamp formed 15,000 years ago during the last Ice Age, when glaciers inched close but never reached Maryland.

### Fall Foliage Heritage Driving Tour – Northern Garrett County

This self-guided driving tour will take you off-the-beaten-path and highlight some of Garrett County's most scenic spots. Enjoy a long drive along the Savage River Reservoir. Situated along the Big Savage Mountain landscape, this breathtaking body of water is a local's favorite for kayaking. A drive through Big Run State Park will also provide some great photo opportunities. These winding country roads are sure to produce some wildlife sightings as well.
