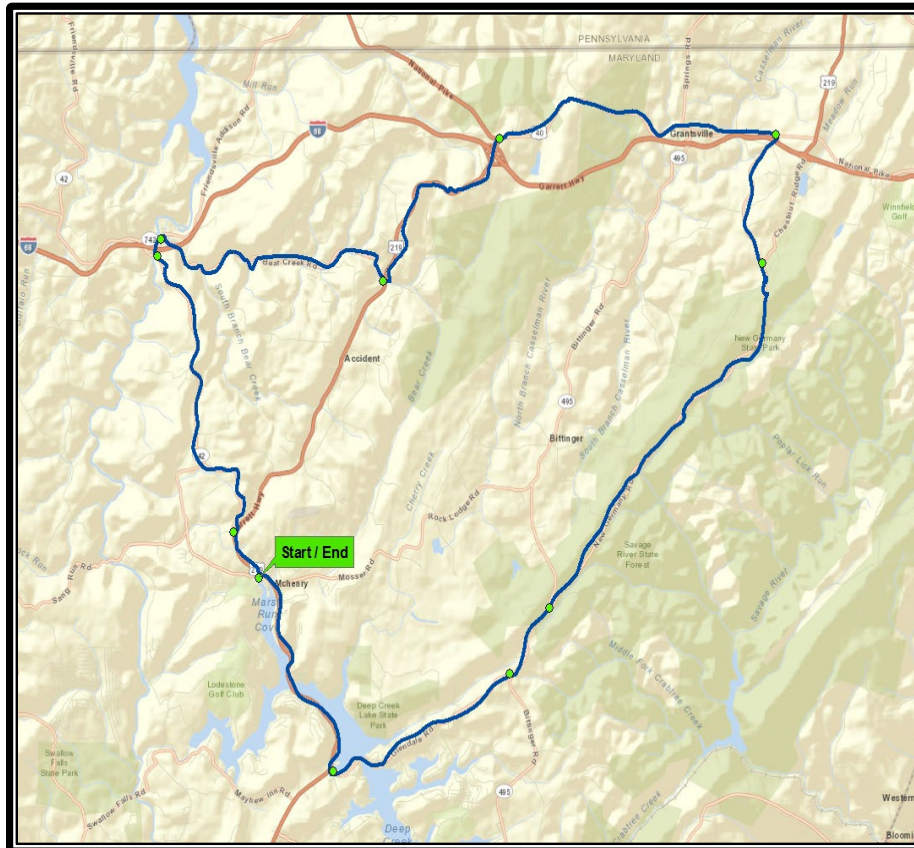


Fall Foliage Driving Tours 2024

Directions:

- A. Start at Garrett County Chamber of Commerce/Visitors Center, 15 VISITORS CENTER DR., MCHENRY 21541
- B. Turn LEFT onto GARRETT HWY (US-219)
- C. Continue 0.03 miles Turn LEFT onto Friendsville Road / MD- 42
- D. Continue North on Friendsville Road for 7.2 miles
- E. Turn RIGHT onto 1st Ave.
- F. Turn RIGHT onto Maple St.
 - The Friend Family Association Genealogical Library is on the corner
- G. Maple St. turns into Bear Creek Rd.
- H. Turn LEFT onto US-219 North / Garrett Hwy
 - Scenic Overlook on left, just past Cove Rd
- I. Continue on US-219 crossing over I-68.

- J. Turn RIGHT onto Old National Pike / US-40 alternate, also known as the Historic National Road, a Scenic Byway.
- Fuller Baker Log House Wayside – Historic Log Cabin used by early settlers
 - View the *Double Pinwheel Barn Quilt*, 7880 National Pike, Grantsville
- K. Continue into town of Grantsville. See Side Trips below.
- Grantsville Community Museum – open Friday and Saturday
 - Casselman Inn - Operated as an inn since it was built in 1842. Listed on the National Register of Historic Places, dining available.
 - Casselman River State Park (Historic Casselman Bridge) **Currently Closed for Repairs**
 - Penn Alps Restaurant and Gift Shop / Spruce Forest Artisan Village - the Bridge can still be viewed from the Penn Alps/Spruce Forest complex
- L. Go 1.1 miles and Turn RIGHT onto New Germany Road. See Side Trips below.
- New Germany State Park
 - Savage River State Forest
- M. Make slight LEFT onto MD Rt. 495 / Bittering Rd, a Scenic Byway.
- View the *Snail's Trail Barn Quilt*, 4056 Bittering Road, Swanton, MD 21536
- N. Continue 3.4 miles, Turn RIGHT onto Glendale Rd. See Side Trips below.
- Deep Creek Lake State Park & Discovery Center: turn right onto State Park Road
- O. Turn RIGHT onto Garrett Hwy / US-219 at light. See Side Trips below.
- Deep Creek Lake Scenic Overlook on LEFT
- P. Continue 5.1 miles to Visitors Center Dr. Turn LEFT, return to Garrett County Visitors Center.
